

After graduating in Milan, **Thomas Vaccari** completed his doctoral work with Anne Ephrussi at the EMBL in Germany (2003) and later worked as a Postdoc at UC Berkeley in the lab of David Bilder (2004-2009). Thomas set up his lab at IFOM in 2010 and recently joined the faculty of the University of Milan as an Associate Professor. His lab investigates fundamental questions concerning the role of membrane trafficking in signal transduction during organ development and homeostasis, both in health and in disease. Research in Thomas' lab has been supported by AIRC (Associazione Italiana Ricerca sul Cancro, Telethon Italia and Fondazione Cariplo. Thomas is a founding member of the JEDI (Junior European Drosophila Investigators) network.
